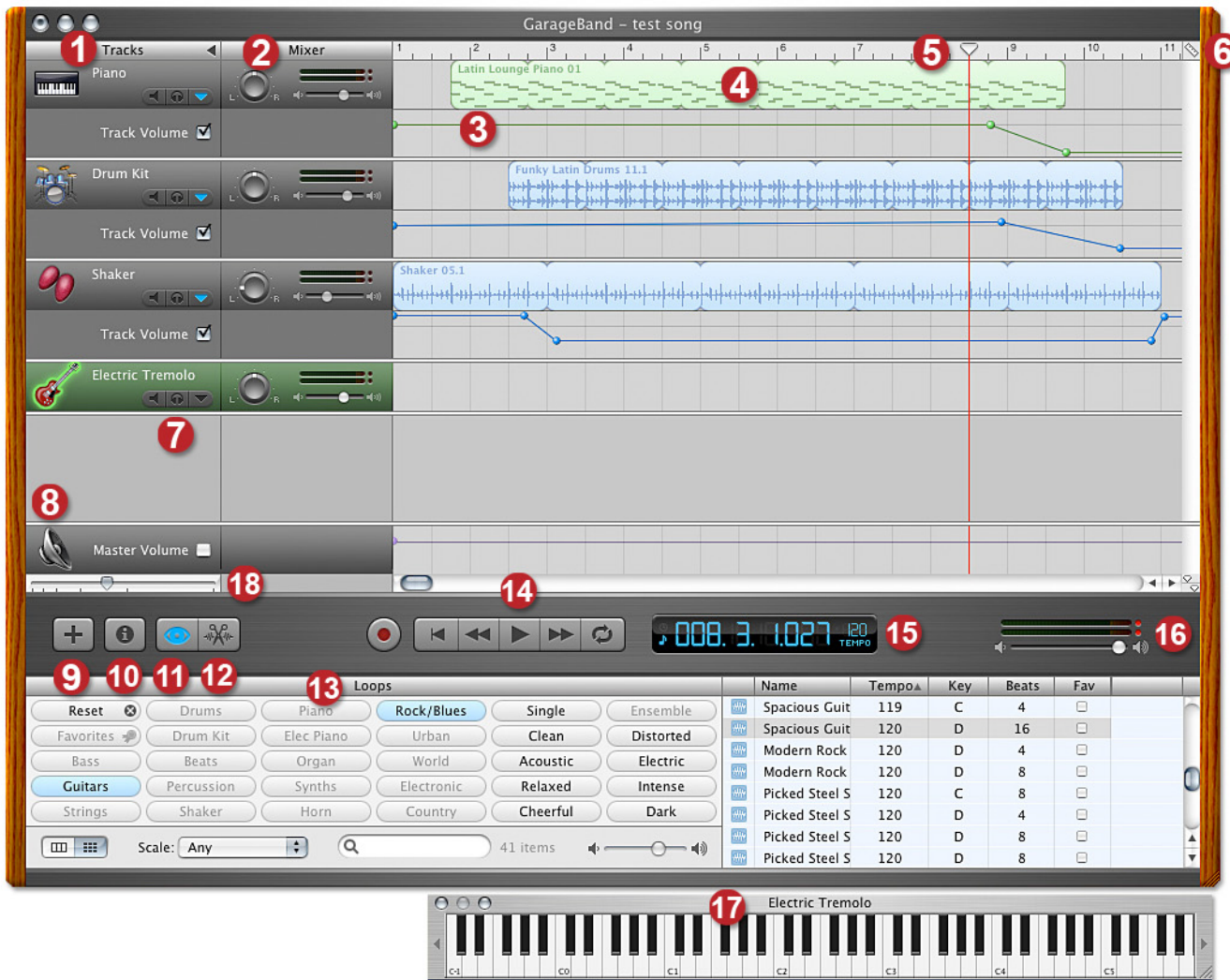


GarageBand Quick Reference



1. Track Listing - shows each instrument on timeline.
2. Track Mixer - controls the balance and volume of each instrument.
3. Track Volume - controls the individual track volume by using points on the volume curve.
4. Track Region - indicates the track placement track on the timeline.
5. Playhead - vertical indicator of where the song is currently playing.
6. Timeline Grid Button - gives note value options for timeline.
7. Track Header Controls:
 - Mute (speaker) - mutes track.
 - Solo (headphones) - plays only selected track.
 - Track Volume (arrow) - places volume curve timeline for selected track volume adjustment.
8. & 16. Master Volume - controls overall volume of song.
9. New Track Button (command + option + N) - adds new track to timeline.
10. Track Info Button - opens Track Info window for instrument detail and selection.
11. & 13. Loop Browser (command + L) - shows program loops with category search.
12. Track Editor (command + E) - shows track specifications and time signature.
14. Transport Controls: record, rewind, play, fast forward and repeat.
15. Time display - digital indicator of the playhead's position on the timeline.
17. Keyboard (command + K) - software instrument control.
18. Timeline Zoom Slider - can adjust the detail of timeline by increasing or decreasing the markers.
